Respected Madam,

Kindly refer to your letter dated 23 May, 2008 regarding disposal of complaints received under NREGS. There is an attachment of a list of 23 complaints along with your above letter. But the complaints posted on the site of NREGA (www.nrega.nic.in on 11.06.2008) are 14 in number and they do not match with the complaints mentioned in the list enclosed with your letter. The status of disposal of complaints posted on site is as follows:

1. The total number of complaints listed on site of NREGA is 14, ranging from serial number 52 to 65.
2. Out of this in case of 4 complaints namely (serial number 52 – complainant Shri Ilyas Azmi; 62- complainant Shri Ashok Gehlot; 64-complainant Shri Mitra Sen Yadav; 65- Shri Akshaya Pratap Singh) detail report/ compliance has already been sent to the Ministry on 8 May, 2008. The same has also been posted on the web site of the department (www.rd.up.nic.in).
3. The report on the complaint of Shri Ashok Gehlot, (complaint at serial number 60) is being forwarded to the Ministry today.
4. Regarding one complaint at serial number 55, (complainant Shri Shyama Charan Gupta), the copy is not legible, so another legible copy was requested from the Ministry on 30 May, 2008. The same is still awaited.
5. The remaining 8 complaints listed on serial number 53, 57, 58, 61 (complainant- Shri G.C. Dinkar); serial number 54 (complainant- Shri Lal Chand Kol); serial number 56 and 63 (complainant- Shri Shailendra Kumar); and on serial number 59 (complainant – Shri Praveen Rashtrapal) are not available in this office. A special messenger (Shri Anil Upadhyaya) from this office was sent to the Ministry on 26 May, 2008 to get a copy of all the pending complaints. He contacted Mr. R.K. Sood, Under Secretary in the Ministry, but could not get a copy of the pending complaints. In absence of the copies of above complaints it may not be possible to take appropriate action for their disposal.

In above background, I would like to request you to direct the concerned officials for sending the copy of complaints being shown pending on the NREGA website, and also to delete the complaints from the site, in which action has been completed and reported to the Ministry.
