Sub: Complaint by Mr. Ashok Gehlot regarding alleged corruption of funds under NFWP & Starvation death in District Kushinagar.

Madam,

An inquiry was conducted by the District Magistrate Kushinagar regarding the allegation mentioned in complaint letter(a copy of inquiry report enclosed herewith). The main allegation pertains to the allocation of works to U.P. Sram & Nirman Sahakari Sangh in violation of guidelines and it has been also alleged that there was death due to starvation so assistance should be given to the families. The D.M in her finding has categorically denied any starvation death in the district. As far as irregularities in work allocation to U.P. Sram & Nirman Sahkari Sangh is concerned the D.M. in her report has clearly mentioned that the works were allocated to the concerned agency in accordance with the guidelines of NFWP and a physical verification of worksites has also been done to ascertain the quality of works which have been found satisfactory. It is pertinent to mention here that Government of India had also nominated Mr. D.N. Singhal, National Monitor for the physical verifications in the district and he visited the district from Nov,14<sup>th</sup> to Nov, 18<sup>th</sup>. Mr. Singhal has also not mentioned any anomalies after his visit. In view of the inquiry report submitted by the DM Kushinagar it is requested to close this matter henceforth.

Sub: Complaint by Mr. Ilyas Azmi, M.P. regarding alleged corruption of funds under NFWP in District Lakhimpur Kheeri.

Madam,

Kindly refer to the complain letter of Mr. Ilyas Azmi, M.P. regarding the alleged corruption in implantation of the NFWP in Lakheempur Kheeri District. The main allegation is that there was wide spread corruption in implementation of the scheme and because of corruption his proposals were not taken in the scheme. A detailed report in this regard has been received from CDO in which he clearly mentions that the works taken up in the scheme were done strictly according to the guidelines of the scheme.

As far as the proposals of the Honb'le M.P. are concerned there were in total 230 proposals received out of which only 97 were in accordance with the guidelines of the scheme, however, because of lapse of foodgrain of 558.23 Lacs in the district only 24 works could be taken. As far as corruption in implantation of the scheme is concerned the CDO in his report has mentioned a detailed monitoring procedure followed in the district in which not only senior officials did routine inspections but also the photographs and videography of works has bee recorded for monitoring purpose and it is pertinent to mention here that in his report CDO has also mentioned about the visits of Mr. V.S. Chauhan, National Monitor, Mr. Ashok Mehta, Dy. Sect, Govt. of India, who also found the works satisfactory. In view of the report of CDO, it is requested to close the matter henceforth.

Sub: Complain by Mr. Ashok Gehlot regarding actions against officials found guilty in misuse of funds in village Bilwai, District Mahoba.

Madam,

A report has been received by CDO Mahoba regarding the incidence(copy attached herewith). The main complain is that despite irregularities found in physical verification and filing of FIR no action has been initiated against the culprits. In his report the CDO has mentioned that on the basis of the complain a FIR was lodged, however, after inquiry the police could not find evidence of use of tractors. TAC verification of the works in the village suggested some irregularities in measurement of the work and for that a departmental proceedings has been ordered by the competent authorities against those responsible for irregularities. In view of the report submitted by CDO as departmental proceedings has been ordered against the guilty officials it is requested that the matter may be closed henceforth.

**Sub: Complain by Akshaya Pratap Singh regarding no work allotment to Zila Panchayat in District Pratapgarh**

**Madam,**

**A detailed report in this matter has been sent by D.M. Pratapgarh( copy attached herewith). The main allegation is that no work was assigned to Zila Panchayat in NREG Scheme in last one and half year. The D.M. in his report has mentioned that during the year 2006-2007, 604.00 Lacs amount was sanctioned to Zila Panchayat against the approved works, however, even after completion of financial year the utilization of the amount sanctioned has not been submitted and about 53 projects are yet to be completed.**

**Again, in his report DM has categorically mentioned that most of the projects submitted by Zila Panchayat were of very small nature that can be easily done by Gram Panchayat. Zila Panachayat has been requested to take up those project that are of inter-block nature. Again a verification of works done by Zila Panchyat has suggested that almost in all the works contractors were used which was clear violation of the spirit and guidelines of the Scheme. A detailed inquiry into the conduct of Zila Panchyat is continuing in the district. The D.M. in his report hs clearly mentioned that there has been no violation of guidelines in allocation of fund and works in**

the district. In view of the report submitted by District Magistrate Pratapgar, it is requested to close this matter henceforth.

Sub: Complain by Shri Shyam Singh Patel, MLC, regarding irregularities in allocation of fund in Sonbhadra

Madam,

A detailed report in this matter has been sent by D.M. Sonbhadra( copy attached herewith). The main allegation is that there was disbursement of 10.50 Crore without sanction and meeting of Zila Panchayat and only four blocks were allocated fund out of eight Blocks. In his report the D.M. has mentioned that according to para 7.3.13 of NREGA guidelines, after the utilization of 60% the next installment is due and for that no sanction of Zila Panchayat is required. Again, the fund was allocated to all 8 blocks and not restricted to 4 only as mentioned in the complain. The D.M. has informed that the procedures has been explained to the representative of Hon'ble MLC and he has been satisfied with the replies and response of D.M. in this regard. In view of above mentioned facts it is requested to close this matter henceforth.
