1.	Information, Education and Communication Officer	Graduate from a recognized university. Work experience for at least 10 years in this field.	Work experience in rural development department will be given preference.
2.	Social Audit and Works Officer	Graduation in any of the disciplines under Arts, Social Sciences/Social Work or equivalent degree with 5 years experience in Monitoring & Evaluation/Social Audit of programmes	Should have hands on practice and experience in evaluation and monitoring the impact of developmental works on public/community. Work experience in rural development department will be given preference.
3.	Finance Officer	Graduation degree in Commerce(Finance)/ICWAI/CA/any equivalent degree with work experience of 5 years.	Work experience of handling any government sponsored programme/ project will get preference.

2. Contract Period: The contract period will be initially for one year and will be renewed thereafter depending on the performance.

3. Age: The applicant should not be less than 26 years and more than 60 years on 1st January 2009.

4. Emoluments: The working hours in a week and the remuneration will be negotiated keeping in view the expectations, qualifications and work experience of the applicant; and the requirements of the NREGS Cell.
